Concern Reporting Procedure

Anyone who is concerned about the well-being of a child or adult at risk, or who has a disclosure of abuse or neglect made to them must:

RESPOND

- Reassure the child/adult.
- Listen carefully and calmly.
- Note down what you are told (or have observed) with dates and times.
- Keep questions to a minimum.
- Do not promise secrecy. (See Appendix B for guidance.)

REFER

- If someone is in immediate danger call the Police (999).
- If someone is NOT in immediate danger: Speak to our Welfare Officer (below) If unavailable, call the LTA Safeguarding Team or NSPCC for advice.
- Inform the parent/carer of the concern, unless you believe it will put the child, adult at risk or yourself at risk.

RECORD

- Write down an account of your concerns as soon as possible after the event.
- Call or email our Welfare Officer to report (below). Please include details (who?, where?, what?, when? ages of any children, your concerns and your contact details).
- Or click to fill in Game4Padel's Report a Concern Form. [to follow]
- Your information will be treated in confidence but shared, if appropriate, with the LTA Safeguarding Team and/or local Authorities. Alternatively, you can report directly to LTA Safeguarding (below).
